2.6.2 Attainment of Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes are evaluated by the institution

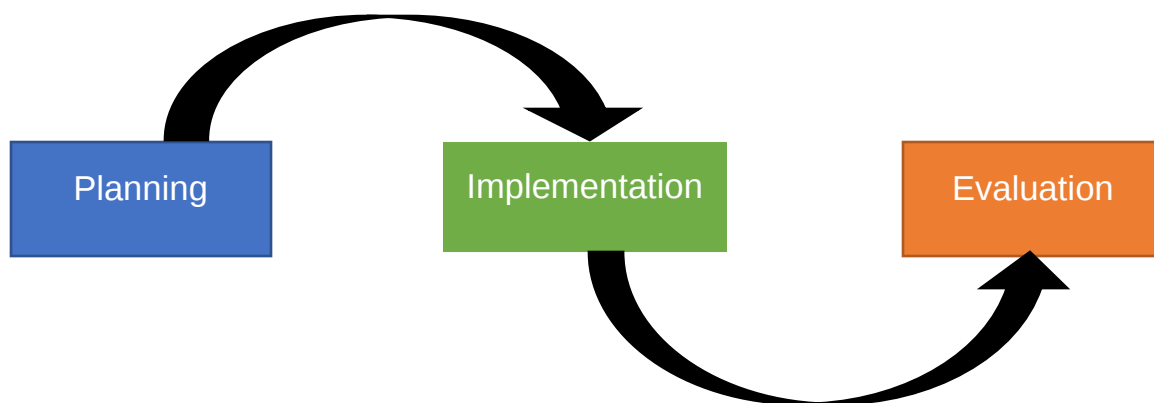
Description:

For any institution to achieve academic growth and success, the vision and the outcomes plays an extensive role. The outcomes regarding the programme and the course are pivotal elements which are essential for attainment for any institution. To attain these, the institution goes through three paramount components:

1. Planning phase
2. Implementation phase
3. Evaluation phase

1. Planning phase:

The planning phase is the initial process where the outcomes are defined with respect to the programmes and the courses offered by the institution. The outcomes are framed based on the curriculum of the academic entities through which a skeleton of the academic framework is setup. The programme outcomes are specific enough to explain how those broad expectations are accomplished within a given program, and course outcomes will specify what expectations an instructor has for the course, which are related to one or more program outcomes.



2. Implementation phase:

Once the planning phase is carried out efficiently, the next successive step is to implement the framework actions regarding the outcomes with respect to the programmes and courses. This step consists of implementing the tools in the planning phase. Additionally, the maintenance of records

related to all tools and processes is also carried out exquisitely in this phase of implementation. For any process to efficiently attain success, implementation phase is the most paramount step.

3. Evaluation phase:

The outcomes defined in the planning phase → implemented alongside with the necessary tools in the implementation phase → are cumulatively evaluated in the evaluation phase which acts as the final process for attainment of outcomes. The records maintained in the aforementioned step are preserved and precisely evaluated. This is followed by the comparison of the evaluated records to the expected level based on which the process of attainment is carried out.

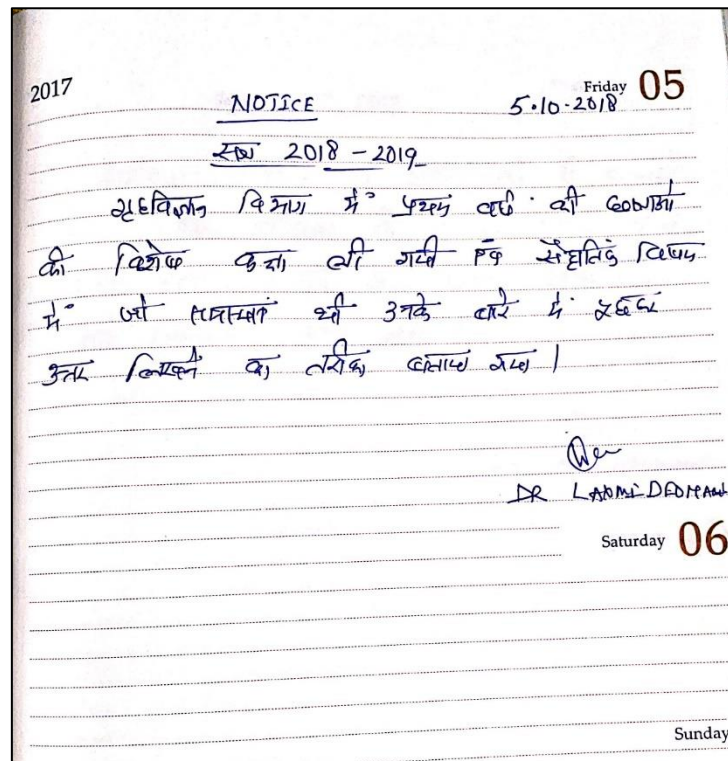
