Annual Report stated by the Principal

(2019-20)

- Admission At the commencement of the session, the admission procedure was completed
 as per the rules and regulations of the Department of Higher Education/University. A total
 of 856 students were admitted into the institute.
- Statutory Committees In the start of every session, Anti-ragging committee, Discipline committee, Scholarship committee, Grievance Redressal committee, Women Harassment committee and Reserved Category committee are formed and placed into action with the earliest form of implementation. Till date, the institute has never experienced any complaint regarding the ragging activities. To maintain a proper discipline and supervision in the institute, the outside elements are not provided entry into the institute.
- Academic Calendar For the academic year 2019-20, the Department of Higher Education and the University released the academic calendar. The faculties were directed to properly follow the academic calendar. The internal assessment and unit tests are to be followed as per the academic calendar. The faculties strictly followed the directions, and all the actions and assessments were done at the prescribed time frame. Adherence to academic calendar is strictly monitored.
- Scholarship 552 students belonging to the reserved category (436 from OBC; 31 from ST and 85 from SC) were provided with scholarships as per Government schemes and norms.
- Sports As per the sports calendar provided by the Higher Education and Pt. RSU, the sports activities were organized accordingly. The students participated in the following sports:

- NSS In the year 2019-20, NSS organized innovative and impressive activities like blood donation camps, sickle-cell anemia awareness camps, Yoga Day, Tree Plantation drives, Water Awareness rallies. Vidhan-Sabha tour etc. were organized. Gandhi chitra (photo) exhibition was organized in the Gandhi Jayanti week. Additionally, activities like No Plastic Awareness camp, Sadbhawana Oath ceremony, Study tours, Katthak training workshops and cancer awareness programmes were organized precisely and effectively by the NSS unit of the institute. Due to the unexpected arrival of COVID-19 pandemic, the last quarter of the academic year experienced online medium of activities like numerous web-talks, webinars and NSS short film presentations to grasp an idea of NSS activities carried out in the session.

 day is also organized where the winners are awarded with the prizes and awards. This year,

Waste, Singing, Dancing, Fancy Dress, Salad Decoration, Pooja Thali Decoration, Bridal competitions, Hair Style and many more. The faculties and staff provide immense contributions in the efficient arrangement and commencement of the aforementioned competitions and activities. The Education Minister of Chhattisgarh Government and local MLA were the guests of the annual prize distribution ceremony of the institute.

- Student Union As per the notification of the affiliating university, the student union was constituted successfully. Office bearers and class representatives were nominated on the basis of merit.
- Research Activities The institute has research centers in Hindi and Home Science disciplines under which, the students carry out their research efficiently.
